

1. What is the major educational need this grant addresses?

Captivating our students in this ever-changing technological world is a continual challenge in today's classroom. The expansive program takes teaching to the next level by providing us, as educators, with the vibrant, compelling digital media we need to connect with today's student.

United Streaming is unique in that it focuses on students at all levels. The media reaches students with exceptional capabilities, assists the learning of those on level, and provides accommodations for students who need another source to grasp a given concept. Because of the generosity of your organization, we have successfully incorporated this technology into our classrooms and have become accustom to using it to bring our presentations to "life". 2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

The projected enrollment at Thomas Middle School for the 2011-2012 school year is 300. All of these students would have the opportunity to utilize this technology and use the enrichment they receive from the program for years to come.

3. Describe your grant using methods, materials, and objectives.

United Streaming is the most comprehensive digital teaching resource available today. The program meets the need to incorporate technology while presenting material that will increase student understanding in any given subject. It is broken down by curricula area. These areas include: math, language arts, science, social studies, careers, health, visual and performing arts, world languages, and teaching practices. The variety of such a distribution speaks for itself. United Streaming includes more than 5,600 full-length videos, over 45,000 content-specific clips, 27,000 encyclopedia articles, 1,500 pre-made quizzes, as well as, math explanations, writing prompts, clip art, and much more. All of these items can be directly tied to our state and national standards.

It is continually challenging for a teacher to find different ways to know how to present a skill in a manner that all students will benefit from. For many students, it seems unclear why they need to learn a specific objective.
