

Ahoy Matey... "Come Aboard the Ship of Reading Success"

1. What is the "major" educational need this grant addresses?

The demand for students to perform at or above grade level in Reading is at an all time high. It is our desire to make sure that each and every student at Thomas Middle School reaches this level or above. After using and assessing programs that will help facilitate this goal, "ReadingMate" stood out as a program that would assist our students the most.

"ReadingMate" is a supplemental reading intervention program that prepares students to read at grade level and develop the necessary reading skills for a successful future. It provides a web-based, individualized learning environment with an instructional design based on the key points of the English Language Arts and Reading Standards. The program offers students the opportunity to read independently and comprehend increasingly complex texts from a variety of genres all while providing the students in an entertaining learning environment.

The Holdenville Education Foundation has been a "bright spot" in our school and community during this challenging time in education. The organization's generosity has continuously given Holdenville's educators the tools necessary to improve our students' achievement. I ask that you continue with this commitment by purchasing a subscription to "ReadingMate" for the 2014-2015 school year.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

This project would directly affect 100 students at Thomas Middle School. In addition, the potential of it increasing our test scores and improving the district report card would indirectly impact the entire school system.

3. Describe your grant including methods, materials, and objectives.

The ultimate objective of this grant is to provide a target group of students (students that are currently performing below grade level) an individualized reading plan to prepare them to read at grade level and develop the necessary reading skills for High School, College, and beyond.

The "ReadingMate" program begins with the students taking a placement test to determine their reading level in the program. Once this has been completed each student has a "path" to follow. This path begins the student on their individual level and progresses with them. The program includes interactive reading lessons with engaging vocabulary and comprehension activities, vocabulary development, and reading instruction.

This project involves purchasing a site license (of up to 100 users) of the "ReadingMate" program. We would like to utilize the program in a small group setting to make it the most beneficial for "at risk" students.

4. Give a time schedule of implementation.

As soon as the funding becomes available, a subscription to the "ReadingMate" program would be purchased and the implementation process would begin immediately. We would continue to utilize the program throughout the year's subscription.
