1. What is the Major Educational need this grant addresses?

Reed Elementary School has been able to acquire 2 additional carts of ipads that are available for check-out by teachers to use in their classrooms. Headphones were not provided with the ipads, but are needed for use in a group setting. We have been able to purchase new Reading and Math programs for all students to use in the computer lab as well as on the ipads and other classroom computers. An important piece of this new curriculum is technology oriented with interactive texts. Students must have access to these materials in their classrooms. Also, every student at Reed Elementary is required to spend a minimum amount of time each week using Lexia, which we received a grant from the Oklahoma Department of Education to purchase. All of our grants from The Oklahoma Department of Education require data from the students' use of the technology. It is a necessity for each and every student to be able to correctly hear the material in order to give accurate information about their progress.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

There will be approximately 475 students affected by this grant. Each classroom will use the ipads every week.
