

1. What is the major educational need this grant addresses? Please give grade level and academic area.

Fifth grade is a testing year. Students are tested in EVERY subject. The iPad has shown to have tremendous success being used in the classroom. Text books are being designed specifically for the iPad. This would cost less than text books and would be a cost saving practice. State achievement tests for 5th grade will soon be taken on computers as the upper grades already do. The iPad is also a great tool to use for learning-disabled students.

There are countless apps and programs available to help students in every subject. In my core subject they can be used in several ways, the most important being research for the state writing test they are required to take. Students are able to work at their own pace with assignments designed just for them and their specific needs.

There are also programs and apps to help teachers to be more effective.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

An unlimited number. For this specific purpose, all of the fifth grade, this year averaging approximately 100 students. They can be used in all fifth grade classrooms, teaching all the core subjects, in the weekly DIBBLES testing, in AR tests, and extra credit assignments. They can also be shared with all other grades if and when the need is there.

The iPad can also be used as a great tool for teachers to monitor student progress, and to enable teachers to help remedial students as well as provide advanced instruction from dozens of apps currently not available to them
