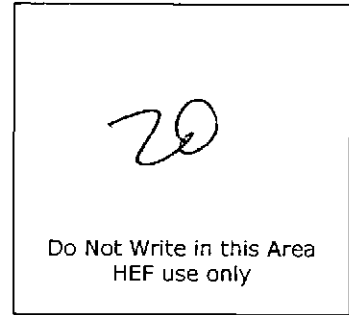

1. What is the major educational need this grant addresses? Please give grade level and academic area.

I strive to provide a literacy rich classroom for my students with multiple opportunities to explore and engage in a variety of reading activities. A listening center would allow my students to enjoy a variety of texts in a comfortable, small group setting with peers. Afterward, students will respond to the text through various extension activities. The Listen and Learn Early Comprehension Activity Program will provide students a hands on learning experience with key reading skills such as sequencing, and main idea.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

This project will affect students in my first grade classroom for years to come. I will also utilize the materials in after school tutoring, summer school, and reading intervention programs. I am confident the early intervention and exposure to key reading skills in the first grade will boost their success beyond my classroom and in the years that follow. The knowledge and reading skills my students obtain through these learning experiences will serve as a foundation they can build upon as they advance in the educational journey.

3. Describe your grant including methods, materials and objectives. organize the materials. The Listen and Learn Early Comprehension Activity Program includes four CDs and a variety of interactive write on activity cards with reading activities that correspond with the CDs. These materials will serve as an extension of classroom instruction. After students learn about these reading skills through direct instruction, they will be able to work with their peers during a small group center activity and practice the skills through the materials this grant would provide.

These materials would be in the hands of my students immediately. My students would be able to use them daily through literacy center rotations.

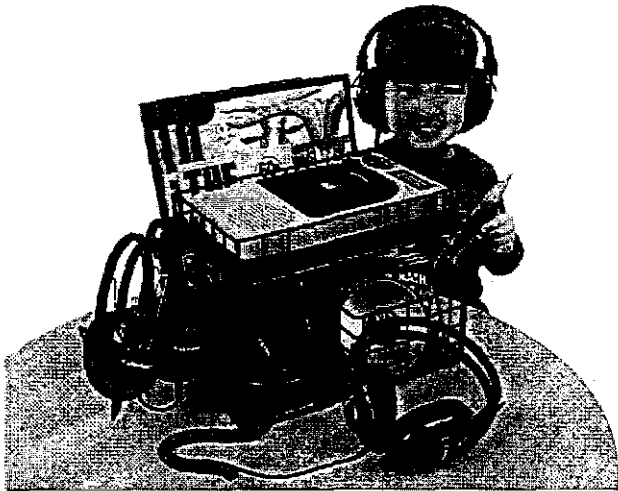

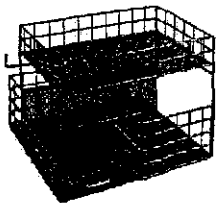
